## Lemania Summer Courses

Lemania Summer Courses are for students who want to participate in the language lessons without staying in the boarding house.

The activities for external students are optional. The students can either select the weekly activities package or can choose specific activities from the range offered at the school.





## Organisation of the Lemania Summer Camp & Courses

### Morning :

English or French lessons

The weeks are structured with intensive language classes for students at different levels of English or French.

The morning lessons are taught by qualified, enthusiastic teachers to small groups with student numbers limited to twelve.

Our language classes emphasize spoken fluency and provide countless opportunities for students to practice the language they are learning, whether in our classes, in conversation with their instructors, or with other native or international participants in the programme.

### Afternoon :

Miscellaneous activities (games, sports, culture and arts) and outdoor excursions are planned for the rest of the afternoon and evenings, to develop students' talents through a rich programme of professionally organized activities.

The best way to improve a language is to practice it all day long during classes, whilst doing activities, playing games or sports coached by a team of friendly and professional instructors.

The Lemania Summer Camp encourages friendship across cultures and languages from around the world. Students discover Switzerland's natural beauty, Swiss tradition and culture.

The Lemania Summer Camp & Courses teach young people how to take their first steps towards becoming responsible individuals in an international environment.

## Games, Activities, Sports

In the early afternoon, students participate in an array of activities available at the School and nearby. Typical afternoon and evenings activities include : visits to UNO in Geneva, the Olympic Museum and the Chillon Castle, Adventure Park, Aquasplash, laser-games, Aquaparc, soccer, volley-ball, basketball, tennis, go-kart racing, ice-tobogganing, labyrinth adventure, barbecue, dancing, paint-ball, swimming, sailing, windsurfing and paddling, as well as painting, music, photography, trips to Geneva, Bern and France, and shopping... (non-exhaustive list).

After a full day of activities, evening study halls allow students to develop their proficiency and skills even further. Students can also spend the evening hours playing recreational sports, relaxing in the student common room in the family boarding house. Weekend activities and excursions are also organised for boarders.

Activities are optional for the Lemania Summer Courses participants.

All activities are included in the Lemania Summer Camp for boarders.



## The International Boarding House

Our international boarding school represents an ideal framework and complements the summer courses. At Ecole Lémania, you will find the structure that best meets your needs and desires.

Lemania College Lausanne considers that an excellent boarding school fosters a family atmosphere in which every student can feel happy and confident.

From the moment they arrive, students are welcomed in a warm atmosphere; a perfect foundation to familiarize oneself with the host country and to quickly make friends from around the globe. In the boarding house students live with others of the same gender and age and are fully supervised by staff who make all students feel at home. Lemania's bedrooms are spacious and extremely comfortable with a view over Lake Geneva or the Alps.

Boarding at Lemania College provides easy access to state-of-the-art academic resources, sports and social facilities, and recreational activities, particularly for full boarders who stay at weekends.



Located in the heart of Lausanne, near the Lake of Geneva and the Olympic museum, Lemania is only a 5 minutes walk away from the Lausanne train station, reached in only 45 minutes from Geneva airport. The International Boarding School provides students with an ideal environment where they can combine culture and studies in the context of an international programme rich in language courses and activities.

After the programme, students receive a full academic report, including a grade, a course description, and the teacher's comments.


## The charms of Lausanne

Dominated by its 13th century gothic cathedral, Lausanne has a current population of about 125000 (250 000 including the surrounding areas).

Lausanne, sitting between vineyards, rich pine forests and the countryside, is situated on the edge of Lake Geneva (the biggest fresh water basin in Western Europe).

It is the Canton Capital for the Canton of Vaud as well as being the Olympic Capital since 1994. It can be easily reached from four different airports.

Lausanne is therefore at the top of the list when it comes to choosing a place to study, allowing one to combine work and leisure with its numerous sports facilities, quality hotels and cultural centres.




So as to work in the best conditions, students can access the richly documented cantonal and university libraries housing varied selections of the best literature.
